

In the spirit of respect, reciprocity and truth, we honour and acknowledge the traditional Treaty 7 territory and oral practices of the Blackfoot Confederacy; Siksika, Kainai, Piikani, and the Stoney Nakoda and Tsuut'ina nations. We acknowledge that this territory is home to the Métis Nation of Alberta, Region 3 within the historical Northwest Métis homeland. Finally, we acknowledge all Nations — Indigenous and non — who live, work and play on this land, and who honour and celebrate this territory.

GlobalFest moved into active partnerships with the Indigenous communities in 2009. We focused our programming efforts with Blackfoot Crossing Historical Park in 2011 and added the Tipi Village in 2012, our tenth anniversary year. Our partnership with the Indigenous communities also expanded into the GlobalFest Human Rights Forum and this year, Blackfoot Crossing Historical Park hosted us for the premier episode of livestreamed cooking program GlobalFest Flavours. Blackfoot Crossing has also been an incredible resource for our Canadian Cultural Mosaic production and is an attraction partner in our tourism marketing campaign.

We feel it is important as a non-profit society in Alberta whose mandate it is to promote multi-culturalism and create opportunities to expand awareness of the many diverse communities located in Calgary, to acknowledge that it has been very hard to hear about the news over these past months what our Indigenous nations and Métis communities have known for many years, but are now coming to light as more and more sites of unmarked and undisclosed burial sites connected to the residential school history of Canada are being discovered.

This is a historical reality that we all need to acknowledge and all those on this land that call Canada home need to address. We need to listen and to hear the lived realities of our First Nations peoples. We cannot change history; we can learn from history. We can take action today and we can work together to find solutions and to support those who have been impacted.

THREE YEAR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE

In 2021 GlobalFest launches the new "Reaching Out" Initiative. As our influence extends into the community, we are reaching out to corporate partners with common alignment to our new mission and vision. We seek support that goes beyond the financials. NEW GLOBALFEST GROVES

At full realization, GlobalFest Groves will be a series of in-community green spaces created collaboratively with OneWorld's cultural association partners. Located alongside pre-existing urban reserves, they will be casual gathering spaces, landscaped with trees, seating areas, interpretive installations and level space for community events. The intent is to ensure the Groves annually capture more in carbon emissions that are generated by GlobalFest activities.

INTERNSHIPS & MENTORSHIPS

The Youth Leaders of Tomorrow Program has seen dozens of student interns work closely alongside GlobalFest staff in every aspect of event coordination. (*See page 10*)

URBAN & YOUTH ARTS PROJECT

The Urban Arts program has connected with over 10,000 youth since 2010, engaging them in art and literacy through in and after school programs. (See page 20)

URBAN ARTS PROGRAM: RETURNING 2022

Since 2010, over 10,000 students have participated in GlobalFest's Urban Arts Program. This specialized arts curriculum helps improve the lives of young Canadians, to build mental wellness and confidence while developing artistic skillsets.

Our mission is committed to building the understanding of diversity by enriching students' learning experiences. Our approach to the arts, culture and heritage programs delivered in Calgary schools include:

- Literacy Program: Using spoken word poetry to teach diction, expression, storytelling and public speaking.
- 2. Artistic Expression: Rapping, breaking, DJing and beat making.



SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAMS

SUMMER CAMP

In the summer of 2019, GlobalFest's Urban Arts Team launched a new summer program – MySummerJourneyYYC. This four-week camp was designed specifically for children of immigrant and refugee families who are still working to find their place in their new communities. The camp was put on hiatus in 2020 due to the ongoing provincial restrictions.

Our plan for the 2022 return of MySummerJourneyYYC is to expand the program from Calgary's core and out to the four city quadrants, plus identifying neighbouring communities with need and interest for these programs in small town and rural areas.

GlobalFest will reach further into Calgary's communities, to build more engaged partners and cause action and resolution. The expanded program includes participants sharing a meal and delving into the core topics, facilitated by local and national leaders, educators and advocates. Beginning with our OneWorld ethno-cultural associations and community partners such as Calgary Catholic Immigration Services and the Center for Newcomers, we are also developing relationships with the Canadian Museum for Human Rights (Winnipeg) and the Institute for Canadian Citizenship (Toronto).


