A NOTE FROM GLOBALFEST





GLOBALFEST - REACHING OUT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE

“Reaching Out” expands on the works that GlobalFest has undertaken for many years in five of key areas.

GLOBALFEST GROVES

Two pop-up events have and will be giving communities a taste of the programming and mini-festival experience that can be created regularly once GlobalFest Groves is at full realization. In-community green spaces are planned – created collaboratively with OneWorld cultural association partners, community associations and developers. Located alongside pre-existing urban reserves, developed as new community spaces, and/or revised existing community spaces, they will be purpose built casual gathering spaces, landscaped with trees, grassed seating areas, interpretive installations and level performance spaces for all manner of community events. The intent is to ensure the Groves annually recapture more in carbon emissions than are generated by GlobalFest festival activities.

INTERNSHIPS & MENTORSHIPS

The Youth Leaders of Tomorrow Program has seen dozens of student interns work closely, alongside GlobalFest staff in every aspect of festival, event planning and coordination. ([See page 8](#))

HUMAN RIGHTS FORUM

GlobalFest’s commitment is to ‘Continue the Dialogue’. Moving from a single weeklong series to a more robust offering, with additional strand-along community forums to explore the findings of the main event. GlobalFest looks forward to re-establishing the Human Rights Forum and Continuing Dialogues in the near future.

URBAN & YOUTH ART

Since 2007, GlobalFest – in partnership with Citizenship and Immigration Canada – has held a citizenship ceremony onsite at Elliston Park during the TD OneWorld Festival. The citizenship ceremony has become an integral part of our annual programming. Over the years GlobalFest has had in excess of 1,100 individuals become Canadian Citizens at Elliston Park and our Human Rights Forum.





URBAN ARTS PROJECT MYSUMMERJOURNEYYYC 2023

As Calgary continues to welcome new foreign residents to our city, the need for vital community programming for the youth who are new to Canada, coming from all parts of the world, continues to grow. 2023 marked the third year for MySummerJourneyYYC, a summer camp initiative for immigrant and refugee youth. We made some strategic changes to the program this year, reducing it from four to two weeks, and reduced the age from 13 - 17 down to 10 - 15 years of age. We worked closely with four different agencies in securing youth who would truly benefit from the program and wish to thank Calgary Catholic Immigration Services, Calgary Immigrant Women's Association, Centre for Newcomers and Immigrant Services Calgary for supporting us in providing youth referrals.

This year's program was packed with of sport, games, music, story-telling, recreational activities, excursions, and learning about the early history of Mohkinstsis. The program was envisioned to build greater self-confidence, independence, language and literacy skills, and social engagement.

A few of the programmed activities included:

- Drum circles provided a fun and exciting outlet of energy, and a focus on healing and purpose and came to a rousing finale of robust drumming and beats through the guidance of Circles of Rhythm.
- A morning of navigating personal stories of ethnicity, led by Andrew Uyeno from Virgin Radio, whose own story of the confusion at being "too Asian and not Asian enough" and how ethnicity can be a unique defining character and strength for each of the youth.
- Building confidence in personal journey and story-telling led by Gayathri Shukla of campfirekinship. The youth explored their own personal stories and gently pushed their confidence in knowing how to tell their stories. Followed by an afternoon of music led by Sasha Spronk "Sashae".



- An excursion to Blackfoot Crossing Historical Park and led by Grant ManyHeads. The youth explored the Blackfoot Nation history and lands, visited the exhibits within the museum and then explored the land, tipi village and so much more.
- A second excursion day of exploring the world of science and TELUS Spark, picnicking on the Spark grounds and then hiking to the Sparrow Gallery in Bridgeland to participate in an arts program, building their perfect room space focusing on their own personal journeys of what they had to leave behind when they came to Canada and what they hope to gain being now in Calgary, led by artist-in-residence and new Canadian Almendra Vergara.

This year's youth came from China, Hong Kong, India, Philippines and Ukraine. We truly had a multi-national experience. Led by Anthony Kha, the youth had an amazing two week experience which we hope will stay with them for years to come.

Sayawan (Folk Dance) has integrated itself into Philippine society for many years and is embedded in Philippine culture. Most of their dances are marked by intricate hand and arm movements accompanied by songs or music. Philippine dances have been categorized by intention or societal functions. Philippine dances convey the artistry of movement and are often associated with life functions such as weddings, the mimicry of birds, or even rituals like the warding of evil spirits.




